

EdChoice Expansion Scholarship - Award Estimate Chart '26-'27 School Year

The EdChoice Expansion Scholarship program calculates your scholarship amount based on what your Federal Poverty Level (FPL) is. Every family has a FPL.

The table below will help you see what your FPL is and how much you will qualify for.

Step 2: Find your closest household income

How to read the chart:

1. Find the number of people in your family/household.
2. Follow that row over to your closest household income.
ODE recommends using your adjusted gross income
(line 11 on your federal 1040 tax return)
3. Follow that column down and you will see what FPL % you are.
4. Under that FPL, you will see the award amounts per student
depending on what grade they are in.
5. **Remember, each FPL% correlates to a different scholarship amount in the EdChoice program. This chart is just to give you an idea of where you will fall. For specific amounts, see the Ohio DEW EdChoice website.**

If your family is under the 200%, you will not need to pay the additional \$134 towards the \$6,300 ICS tuition rate.

Example:

1. Family Size = 4 (Mom, Dad, 4th grader, 2nd grader)
2. Household income = \$170,000
3. FPL=just under 550%
4. Award amounts will be about \$4,360 per student for the year.

Example:

1. Family Size = 2 (Mom, 10th grader)
2. Household income = \$75,000
3. FPL=under 450%
4. Award amount will \$6,166 for the year.

Example:

1. Family Size = 6 (Dad, Mom, 5th grader, 3rd grader, 1st grade, baby)
2. Household income = \$310,000
3. FPL = about 738% (about halfway between 700% and 750%)
4. Award amounts will be about halfway between the 700% and 750% columns. Award amount will be about \$1,090.01 per student for the year.
